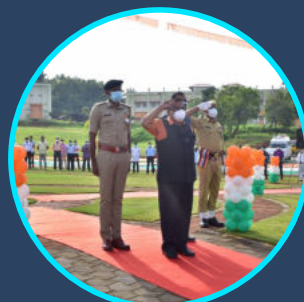

CENTRAL UNIVERSITY OF KERALA

The Central University of Kerala, Kasaragod, came into being in 2009 under the Central Universities Act 2009 (Parliament Act No. 25 of 2009). The University is founded on the noble vision of a 'Caring Wisdom' and is guided by the lofty ideals of academic and social commitment, moral steadfastness and intellectual and spiritual enlightenment, as reflected in the vision statement. The University opened its academic portals in October 2009 with 17 students enrolled in two PG programmes and operated from a rented building at Nayanmarmoola (Vidyanagar) in Kasaragod town. From this humble beginning the University has grown into an institution offering twenty seven postgraduate and twenty two research programmes with a total enrolment of around 2500 students. The campus of the University known as Thejaswini Hills is located at Periyee, Kasaragod on the 310 acres of land allotted by the Govt. of Kerala in 2012. The permanent campus has a built-up area of 6,58,400 Sq Ft. In addition to headquarters located at Periya the University has Law department located at Thiruvalla in Pathanamthitta and BA programme in International Relations is offered at Trivandrum Centre.

CONCEPT NOTE

Higher Education across the world is in a state of flux. The ripples of these changes has definite impact on Indian higher education system as well. The emergence of a knowledge society, knowledge economy, the resultant changes in labour market, demographic features, automation, and the herald of fourth industrial revolution are some key sources that induce need for structural change in higher education system. Invoking the spirit of all these future demands, the NEP 2020 is envisaging structural changes in Indian higher education system. In the context of NEP 2020 the next decade is going to be the apogee of changes in Indian higher education system. The new National Education Policy (NEP 2020) is heralding a new dawn of higher education system in India.



ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

Since the nation has adopted the National Educational Policy, the changes to be initiated by various agencies is a key question. Major initiatives have to come from the central and state governments in the form of financial support, changes in the relevant rules and regulations pertaining to higher education, institutionalization of the new national level and state level agencies to facilitate the implementation of the policy. Though great deal of work has to come from the government all such initiatives need to be operationalized by the institutions offering higher education. In this regard, the role of Universities is critical. Certain questions are very pertinent: What is level of awareness of our Universities about the NEP 2020? What are the steps to be taken by the Universities to implement the NEP 2020 in their institutions?, What is the status of each University in their process of implementing NEP 2020?

To address the some of questions given above a round table conference on Strategising NEP 2020 implementation is planned at Central University of Kerala. In addition to the roundtable conference deliberations on various topics also are planned.

The discussion of Institutional heads and policymakers is expected to bring better clarity and subject to the way forward in implementing the NEP 2020 in a systematic way. The issues faced by the institutions and the way it was addressed are valuable inputs for the institutions across the country. The best practices of various institutions in implementing the Policy would motivate many institutions who are in the process of implementation. It is strongly believed that when the great minds are put together most valuable ideas shall be churned out. The documentation of the deliberations shall benefit not only the participating institutions, but the institutions across the country. To make it possible, Central University of Kerala is organising a round table conference and deliberations lead by the stalwarts of higher education leaders in the country.
