## **Course Description**

- This 30-hour course from the Department of English is meant for the students of the other departments of the University. It is to help students to learn and use diverse English-Speaking skills for their day-to-day needs and develop listening skills.
- Participants are welcome to use the language lab resources in the English Language Centre at the Department of English and Comparative Literature, 101-Brahmaputra where you can access more than 2000 hours of language practice free of cost<sup>1</sup>.
- This course is not a credit course, but a facilitating course meant to better communication skills. Test/assignment, if any, is only meant to improve speaking skills and measure the improvement.

# Logistics

- Admission: Maximum 200 students
- Batch: Each batch will have a minimum of 50 and a maximum of 60 students.
- Fee: Rs. 200 per student (To be paid to the University account at the time of course registration)
- Course instructors will be paid Rs. 300 per hour
- Timing: The course will be conducted in the DECL classrooms (unless online) after 4:00 PM.
- Registered students get free access to the English Language Lab (101 Brahmaputra) anytime.
- A minimum of 80% attendance in the course is mandatory.
- At the end of the course, a Course Completion Certificate will be paid to Registered students who fulfil the course requirements successfully.
