The abovementioned approval is subject to the following :-

- (i) The approval of UGC for introduction of programmes of study is in principle. Once the executive/administrative bodies i.e. Board of Studies, Academic Council, Executive Council etc. as provided in the Act/Bill are constituted, the approval of the academic courses may be placed before these bodies for ratification.
- (ii) The XI Plan reforms agenda for higher & technical education which include admissions, semester system, curriculum reform, promotion of science education and research, examination system, fee structure, assessment, accreditation, ratings, teachers' competence/motivation, autonomy/ transparency / accountability in institutions etc. may be implemented while establishing and running the proposed activities.
- (iii) A built-in system/component for repair and maintenance of equipment in the Science Departments to obviate under utilization/ unutilisation of the laboratory facilities due to absence of provision and facilities for repairs and maintenance.
- (iv) Construction activities taken up should be according to CPWD rates. A Project Steering Committee should be formed to ensure that the quality of construction is as per the norms. Clear timelines need to be specified in advance and adhered to, to avoid time and cost over-runs. Transparent processes should be followed for procurement of equipment, as per guidelines.
- (v) UGC XI Plan General Development Guidelines in respect of construction work needs to be followed.
- (vi) Services like cleanliness, security, hostel/guest house/Mess, Transport, Horticulture etc. may be outsourced through the registered agencies in their districts/states. Further, rules as per the Government of India are to be followed in this regard.
- (vii) Sanctioned posts are to be filled up in phase manner.
- (viii) University may follow strictly the Government of India/UGC's guidelines regarding implementation of the reservation policy [both vertical (for SCs, STs & OBCs) and

horizontal (for persons with disability etc.)) in teaching / non-teaching posts and also in admissions.

As per procedure laid down by the Commission as intimated by UGC to all Central Universities vide UGC letter No.F.17-1/2002(CU) dated 28<sup>th</sup> April, 2005 (copy enclosed) that the building grants are required to be duly scrutinized by the Building & Works Committee of the University with technical experts on it. Then the proposals in the format given in the Annexure are to be placed for approval in the respective Finance Committees having representative of the UGC and the Ministry of HRD on it. Whereas, it is not feasible to obtain prior approval of Finance Committee, the same may be reported to the Finance Committee in its next meeting for ratification.

With regard to budget allocation for other heads etc. same would be conveyed on receipt of separate budget for new Central Universities from MHRD. In the meantime, you are requested to utilize the grant available with you to meet out the day to day urgent requirements and sent the utilization certificate as per GFR 19-A (copy enclosed) alongwith the statement of expenditure (item-wise).

Kindly find enclosed herewith a copy of minutes of the meeting of Vice-Chancellors of new Central Universities held on 3<sup>rd</sup> March, 2011 in the UGC office for your kind perusal and action if any.

2. In the meeting it was decided that only those academic programmes may be started where the necessary infrastructure facilities/ manpower is available. The proposals in respect of professional courses like Medical, Dental, Nursing, Para-Medical, Engineering & Technology etc. will be considered separately at a later stage. New academic programmes should meet the regional requirements, national aspirations and should be at par with the world class standards. Further, the university should make an assessment of the existing academic programmes as may be available in the adjoining Universities so as to avoid gaps and duplications.
3. Based on the above deliberation, I am directed to convey the approval of UGC to open maximum of 20 departments by the end of XI Plan for which no prior approval of UGC will be required. Accordingly, 140 teaching positions are approved (1 Professor, 2 Associate Professor and 4 Assistant Professors for each department) including the existing programmes which had already been approved by the UGC. After establishing the departments, the university may intimate the status to the UGC.
4. Further, based on the discussions in the meeting as well as the availability of funds from Government of India, MHRD, UGC has approved the Annual Plan Allocation (2011-12) of Rs. 50.00 crores for Central University of Kerala under General Development Grant including Merged Scheme and Fellowship to Non-NET Ph.D and M.Phil. The Annual Plan Allocation is tentative and the situation would be reviewed during October – November, 2011.
5. This abovementioned allocation is in addition to the unspent balances as on 1.4.2011 available with the University. University may decide the priorities and provide item wise break-up for General Development Grant (separately for Grant-in-aid General and Capital Assets), Merged Scheme and Fellowships to Non-NET Ph.D. and M.Phil. to UGC within the allocation as mentioned above.
6. It is once again requested that the University may follow the procedure for construction of buildings as circulated vide this office letter number F.17-1/2002 (CU) dated 28<sup>th</sup> April, 2005 (copy enclosed) as well as prescribed in the UGC guidelines for General Development Assistance to Central Universities during XI Plan. The Building Committee should be constituted as per UGC guidelines and information in the prescribed format may be sent to UGC.

7. University may not initiate the work / project i.e. approach road, water pipe line, electric sub-station etc. which are the responsibility of the State Government. University may take up the matter with State Government or Central Government as the case may be.

8. The release of grant would depend on the pace of expenditure by the University & timely submission of utilization certificate supported by the statement of expenditure.
