





They taught us the importance of Critical and Analytical thinking & Public speaking and Emotional Intelligence to lead a good professional and personal life.



Dr. Patrick said there is a need of critical thinking among our students other than getting marks in answer scripts. Both Analytical and Critical thinking is a soft skill which should be developed in this 21st century on his topic **"Soft skills in Critical & Analytical thinking".**
