





News Abstract

Prof. (Dr.) Sundari Ravindran, retired professor at Achutha Menon Centre for Health Sciences Studies, Sree Chitra Tirunal Institute of Medical Sciences and Technology, Trivandrum visited the Department of Public Health and Community Medicine, Central University of Kerala on 29th and 30th August 2019. During her visit the department organized a Public Lecture on “Sexual and Reproductive Health Rights” and a One-day workshop on “Concepts and Methodological approaches to researching health inequities and intersectionality”.

The public lecture was attended by over 100 participants with students and faculty from various departments actively participating. The ideas of how gender norms interfere with the realization of individual's sexual and reproductive rights were discussed. The participants actively engaged in the discussion by asking relevant questions. The one-day workshop was conducted for MPH students of Department of Public Health and Community Medicine as part of the course health inequities. The workshop was an interactive one with lectures and hands on exercise involving active participation from the participants. Several key concepts revolving around health inequity, intersectionality, and methodological approaches in understanding them were discussed. The conduct of the workshop was facilitated by Ms. Jayalakshmi Rajeev, Assistant Professor, Department of Public Health and Community Medicine.

The workshop and the public lecture provided the participants with a broad picture of understanding the inequities in health care service delivery and access through gender lens and equipped them with the methodological tools for undertaking public health research in this area.
