







Tobacco is one of the most common preventable causes of disease, disability and death. Tobacco kills more than 7 million people every year and is considered to be a major risk factor for non-communicable diseases such as cardio-vascular diseases, stroke, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease and cancer. Currently, there are over 1.11 billion smokers globally and a higher number of smokeless tobacco users as well. Given that tobacco kills more than half of its users, its consumption in any form is perilous to health and well-being. Avoiding the initiation of tobacco use and quitting tobacco is of utmost importance.

Special Lecture on “Tobacco Control: Overcoming Challenges for a Better Tomorrow”

The Department of Public Health & Community Medicine, organised a special skill development lecture on “Tobacco Control: Overcoming Challenges for a Better Tomorrow” on 21 March 2018. *Associate Prof. (Dr.) Prasanna Mitra*, from Kasturba Medical College, Mangalore delivered this lecture at the Seminar Hall, Periyar Campus, Central University of Kerala. The event was attended by 63 participants including post-graduate students, PhD scholars, faculty members and administrative staff.

The speaker shared information on the burden of tobacco usage and its impact on public health especially in the developing countries with focus on University students and young adults.
