
The Master of Public Health (MPH) programme is spread across four semesters where students are required to complete course work, dissertation and an internship (either in online/offline mode) at a healthcare organization. Our 5th Batch (2019-2021) MPH students are required to undertake a minimum of 4 weeks mandatory internship during March 2021 (Start date: 01 March 2020). However, the duration of the internship can be extended by the host organization as per their requirement, but the students shall be evaluated for only four weeks as per the MPH programme requirement of the Dept of Public Health & Community Medicine.

At the end of internship, student shall be evaluated by the host organization and issued with an internship completion letter/certificate. The objectives of the internship are (but not limited to):

- To provide students with an overall understanding of the health organization in-terms of human resources, planning and implementation of programmes, research projects, linkages and synergies between various department in the organization.
- To expose the student with the practicalities of understanding and addressing current issues and ground realities with the health sector.
- To collaborate and learn through assisting experienced health professionals in a formal organizational set-up engaged in public health
- To assist the organization in studying and addressing some identified issues/problems associated in specific operational areas or programmes with innovative solutions.
