The Eleventh Meeting of the Second Executive Council was held on 27th March, 2015 at the University Headquarters in Tejaswini Hills, Periye.

At the outset, the Vice-Chancellor welcomed the members and expressed his gratefulness to them for making it possible to attend the meeting in spite of their busy schedule.

The Chairperson informed the Council about the sad and untimely death of one of the young Assistant Professors in the Department of Plant Science, Dr. (Ms.) Viji R I, in a car accident near Kodungalloor on 5th March, 2015. The Chairman also informed that she was returning from Trivandrum after attending a Seminar along with her husband, Dr. Sameer Kumar V B who is also a faculty member in the Department of Biochemistry & Molecular Biology. As a mark of respect to the departed soul, one minute silence was observed by the Council members.

The Chairperson informed about the fire in the Campus which engulfed about 30 acres of land having cashew trees and firewood trees. Timely intervention of the local police personnel and Fire Service Department contained the fire from spreading further and the fire was put out in two days' time.

The Chairman also informed the Council that on 10.2.2015 some people having land adjacent to the University boundary have illegally trespassed into the property of the University and forcefully dragged the property into their illegal possession. University had earmarked six metres of land for construction of road for the public that was deeply dug out about two to three metres, posing danger to the compound wall. The total loss is estimated to Rs.35,00 lakh by the CPWD. The local police registered a case and is under investigation. The matter was reported to the MHRD along with the report of the Sub-Collector.

The Chairman expressed his concern over the slow pace of construction work by CPWD and delay in starting the work by RITES. Due to shortage of buildings, the University is not able

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to provide the basic required space to the students, especially the research scholars. The Chairperson also expressed his concern for not being able to provide a proper playground to the students so far.

With these observations, the agenda items were taken up for discussion.

With regard to item EC:02:09:05, the UGC may be informed that the work shall be taken up subject to availability of fund only.





To consider amendments to the Regulations for the Award of the Degree of the Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) of Central University of Kerala, 2012

The Council noted that provisions under clause 2, in the existing Regulation for the Award of the Degree of the Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) were lacking clarity. Therefore, amendments were proposed to clause 2, clause 16 and clause 67 (a) of the Regulations for the Award of the Degree of the Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) as follows:

Existing Clause 2

Clause 2: "Candidates seeking part-time registration may be considered only where the respective Departmental Research Committee is convinced that effective supervision and a minimum attendance of 60 days, even with breaks, in a calendar year can be ensured."

Clause 3: Candidates working in research projects in Departments of the University shall be eligible to seek for full-time/parttime registration, provided the Research Guide and the Principal Investigator of the research project are one and the same.

Clause 16: "While Permanent employees of an RRC shall be entitled to seek part-time registration, candidates working in relevant research projects at an RRC shall be eligible to seek full time-registration only"

Clause 67 (a): Permanent teachers of this University, not below the rank of Assistant Professor, holding a Ph.D. degree, except obtained through distance education programme

Amendment to Clause 2

"Candidates seeking part-time registration may be considered only where the respective Departmental Research Committee is convinced that effective supervision and a minimum attendance of 60 days, even with breaks, in a calendar year can be ensured.

Provided, however, that part-time Registration shall be permissible only in the case of teachers of Government/Aided Colleges and/or Central/State Universities,

Clause 3: Candidates working in research projects in Departments of the University shall be eligible to seek for full-time registration, provided the Research Guide and the Principal Investigator of the research project are one and the same.

Clause 16: While permanent faculty members/Research staff of an RRC shall be entitled to seek part-time registration, candidates working in relevant research projects at an RRC shall be eligible to seek full time-registration only.

Clause 67 (a): "The permanent teachers of this University, not below the rank of Assistant Professor, holding a Ph.D. degree, and who have either at least one year of post-doctoral experience in a reputed institution, or have proven their research competence as evidenced by publications in refereed Journals after obtaining their Ph.D. degree". Clause 67(b): "Teachers on deputation to this University, and Adjunct/Visiting Faculty in

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this University, who were either recognized Research Guides at their parent University, or who have proven their research competence as evidenced by publications in referred journals after obtaining their Ph.D. degree ".

Clause 67(c): "A teacher on deputation shall take only two research scholars under him/her for Ph.D. Programme, and once the teacher repatriated to parent institution it shall be the responsibility of the Department to allow the Ph.D. scholars to continue their research under the existing or newly joined faculty of the Department".

The Executive Council also noted that the Academic Council, vide item AC: 02:02:21, perused the amendment and recommended to EC for consideration.
