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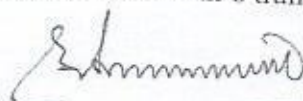
The Minutes of the Sixth Meeting of the Executive Council held on 25th June, 2014 were confirmed as there were no adverse comments.

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The Council noted that the Action Taken Report on the sixth meeting of the Second Executive Council held on 25th June, 2014 would be presented in the next meeting.

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The Council noted that Shri Dinoop P, Junior Assistant (LDC) was selected for the post of Probationary Officer, Syndicate Bank and had been relieved from the University service on 23rd May, 2014 A/N. Shri Dinoop joined the said post after undergoing one month's training

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on 23rd June, 2014. After joining the post, he had requested to be granted lien from CUK (i.e., parent institution) as he would be on probation for a period of two years in Syndicate Bank.

Shri Dinoop had applied for the post of Probationary Officer, Syndicate Bank through online during the year 2013 and the University Administration had issued No Objection Certificate to attend the interview held on 3rd January, 2014.

Shri Dinoop had joined at CUK as Junior Assistant (LDC) on 8th May, 2012 A/N and had rendered 2 years and 16 days of service in the University against the minimum period of probation of two years in the post of Junior Assistant (LDC).

Lien represents the right/title of a Government employee to hold on regular basis either immediately or on the termination of the period or period of absence, a post, including a tenure post, to which he has been appointed on regular basis or on which he is not on probation.

The Council discussed the matter at length and noted that Shri Dinoop had resigned from University service without asking for lien. Lien is granted prior to relief from an organization. Therefore, the Council declined to grant lien to Shri Dinoop.

He will be paid consolidated pay on the basis of last pay drawn minus pension.

The faculty required as per UGC norms (1:2:4) be filled up on regular basis so that the quality of teaching is not compromised. The Centre be nourished to develop it to a full-fledged Department. Another member suggested that regular faculty be appointed towards the end of the second year of the programme. The Council, however, in principle, decided to strengthen the Department by appointing regular faculty.</p> <p>With regard to engagement of senior faculty on contract, the Vice-Chancellor informed the Council that in spite of floating advt. through website, the response was very poor.
