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Taking note of the developments, the Executive Council deliberated on the issue and found that the proceedings till now are in order as prescribed in the Ordinances and Statutes. It is further resolved that

The Registrar is the competent authority to initiate disciplinary proceedings under 6(5) of the Statutes and as per the Ordinances approved by the Executive Council governing service conditions of the Non-Teaching employees. However, he is bound to make over the matter to the Vice Chancellor/Appointing authority in terms of 6(5)c of the Statutes in case inquiry discloses that the punishment beyond the power of the Registrar is called for. In such a case, the Registrar shall make a report to the Vice Chancellor along with his recommendations and the Vice Chancellor/Appointing Authority shall be competent to impose any of the penalties prescribed in Rule 11 of the CCS (CCA) Rules, as felt desirable. As per Section31 (1) of Central Universities Act 2009 (No. 25 of 2009) "the Annual Accounts and balance sheet of the University shall be prepared under the direction of the Executive Council and shall, once at least every year, and at intervals of not more than fifteen months, be audited by the Comptroller and Auditor- General of India or by such persons as he may authorize in this behalf"

As per clause (2) of the Section ibid, "a copy of the annual accounts together with the audit report thereon shall be submitted to the Court and the Visitor along with the observations of the Executive Council."

Further, according to the extant instructions of MHRD, Government of India and the C&AG, the Annual Accounts of the University along with the Annual Report, have to be tabled in the Parliament within nine months after the close of financial year. i.e. to ensure to reach the in the Ministry by the third week of November of the year. For achieving these targets, the Annual Accounts and connected documents for 2015-16 are to be submitted to the Audit Office by the end of June 2016 duly approved by the Governing body, i.e the Executive Council of the University as pointed out in DO letter No. OA/AB/2-10/16-17/68 dated 03 June 2016 of Principal Director of Audit (Central), Kochi Br.

As the term of both the Finance Committee and the Executive Council of the University had expired by the end of May 2016 and as the reconstitution of the Third FC and Third EC was yet to be completed, approval of the FC and EC for the provisional annual accounts for 2015-16 was not possible.

In this regard, Section 11(3) the Act lays down, "the Vice Chancellor may, if he is of the opinion that immediate action is necessary on any matter, exercise any power conferred on any authority of the University by or under this Act and shall report to such authority at its next meeting the action taken by him on such matter"

Therefore, as immediate action was required in respect of completion of statutory audit and all works related thereto as stated in para I and para 2 above, the Vice Chancellor, by exercising the powers conferred by Section 11 (3) of the Act and subject to the provisions thereof, on behalf of the Finance Committee and the Executive Council, had accorded approval for the provisional

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Annual Accounts and related schedules and statements therein of the University for the year 2015-16 prepared in the prescribed formats, for forwarding to the Audit Office, Kochi for arranging audit as above. The Annual accounts were submitted to the Audit Office accordingly. C & AG Audit of the accounts and records of the University commenced on 08.07.2016.

The Executive Council discussed in detail the Annual Accounts and resolved to approve the action taken by the Vice Chancellor as above. The EC also directed to bring this matter before the first meeting of the newly constituted Third Finance Committee.
