EC:03:03:04 Activity Report of Central University of Kerala – from the last Executive Council meeting to 3rd February, 2017

A six-member National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) team headed by Prof. Jai Roop Singh, former Vice Chancellor, Central University of Punjab, visited different campuses of the Central University of Kerala (CUK) during 23rd & 27thOctober, 2016. They have closely examined the activities of various departments, laboratories, libraries, administrative blocks, and hostels of the University. The team also reviewed on-going construction activities for various academic buildings at its main Periye campus, sports facilities and activities of the other cells on the university campuses. They also had interactive sessions with the students, faculty, alumni, public and parents separately during the visit.

As per the assessment of the NAAC team, the University was awarded with a grade of B++ (2.76 CGP) Grading in its first phase of NAAC evaluation.

Till the assessment of the NAAC Peer Team, the University had appointed 109 faculty members out of a sanctioned strength of 147 faculty members. During 9–18 January 2017, the University has conducted faculty interviews for filling up of 15 No. of faculty positions (Professor - 6 Nos. and Associate Professor – 9 Nos.). The minutes of the selection committee meeting were placed. On the recommendation of the Selection Committee meeting held during 29 – 31 August 2016, Dr. R. Radhakarishnan Nair and Dr. B.R. Prasannakumar have joined as regular Registrar and Finance Officer of the University for a term of 5 years on 17th October, 2016 and 20th October, 2016, respectively.

Shri. V. Sasidharan, Controller of Examinations of the University, after having completed 5 years of term was relieved of his duties on 02.02.2017 (A/N). Dr. Mohammed Unni Alias Musthafa, Associate Professor, Dept. of Education, has been given the additional charge of the Controller of Examinations. The advertisement inviting applications for the post of Controller of Examinations are also published in the leading newspapers, employment news etc. The same has already been published in the University website also. The last date of submission of applications for the post of Controller of Examinations is 28.02.2017.

The Construction of Academic Buildings and other works are going on One of the academic buildings will be used as administrative block. The details of which will be placed as agenda items, as recommended by the Finance Committee meeting.

During the year 2016, the University has received a total number of 127 RTI applications and answers to these questions have been furnished to the applicants in a time bound manner.

Dr.K.C. Baiju opined that as per the relevant Statute (1) and CUK Ordinance 37 and UGC Regulation (2010) 5.0.0 to 5.1.3, the HoD and Dean of concerned Department may be incorporated in the Selection Committee of Faculty Members.

The Vice-Chancellor, in response to the suggestion, clarified that so far Heads and Deans were not invited to the Selection Committee because many Heads and Deans were candidates for the posts of Professor or Associate Professor. EC:03:03:23 To consider the request submitted by Dr Rajagopal Kammara who resigned from the post of Professor, Department of Biochemistry and Molecular Biology

Dr. Rajagopal Kammara, who joined as Professor in the Dept. of Biochemistry and Molecular Biology on 09.06.2016. He submitted his resignation from CUK on health grounds on 13.07.2016. As per the Written Agreement signed by Dr. Rjagopal Kammara, three months' notice period was required for acceptance of resignation. Hence, as approved by the Vice Chancellor, he had to give three months' notice period or pay three months' salary to the University. Dr. Rajagopal Kammara was not ready to pay three month's salary stating that there is no clause of payment of notice period salary for any shortfall in the probation period. He had also stated that the notice period during the probation period is only one month.

On 09.08.2016, he submitted a letter stating that he would like to pay the remaining two months' salary and requested to relieve him on 16.08.2016 (AN). The request was approved, and he paid two months' salary i.e. Rs. 2,53,710/- to the University on 10.08.2016. Accordingly, Dr. Rajagopal Kammara was relieved from Central University of Kerala on 16.08.2016 (AN). He had requested to place the case in the Executive Council to waive the requirement of notice period, as mentioned in the Written Agreement.

The Executive Council considered the request submitted by Dr. Rajagopal Kammara and decided not to entertain his request and approved the decision taken by the Central University of Kerala. The Council has rejected the request of Dr. Rajagopal Kammara after its careful consideration.

As per the existing policy, Merit Scholarship is being paid to five students in each Department of the University based on the merit assessed by Central University of Kerala @ Rs. 1,500/- per month. For the first Semester, the merit is considered on the basis of score obtained by the students in the Central Universities Common Entrance Test (CUCET) and in the subsequent semesters, it is assessed on the score in the previous Semester examinations.

The University has started the first batch of Master of Public Health & Community Medicine (MPH) in the year 2016 (i.e. March 2016) and now the 2nd Semester of the course is ongoing. We have started the Department of Public Administration and Department of Geology in the month of September 2016 along with other academic courses. The total number of students admitted in the courses of MPH, Public Administration and Geology were 20, 21 and 16, respectively. The University proposed to extend the Merit Scholarship to the students of these Departments in uniformity with the students in the other Departments of the University.

The Finance Committee already deliberated the issue of merit scholarship as above. The comments received from the JS&FA, MHRD on the issue of Merit scholarship was also considered by the Finance Committee and in turn suggested to send the proposal to the UGC for granting Merit Scholarship to the students of Department of Public Health & Community Medicine, Department of Public Administration and Department of Geology. The proposal should be in accordance with the guidelines and existing scheme and should also be reviewed based on the guidelines in this regard. The Committee suggested that the merit scholarship should be limited to the University Rank Holders as per the UGC guidelines. In addition to this, an effort should be made to get CSR support for extending the scheme of merit scholarship.

The Executive Council resolved to approve the proposal in tune with the Finance Committee recommendation. It has been decided that the Merit Scholarship will continue only up to the admission of 2016, for those who are availing the benefit. There is no Merit Scholarship from the Academic Year 2017 batch onwards from the funds of University. Hereinafter, Merit Scholarship will be completely governed as per UGC guidelines.

UGC instructions and guidelines issued from time to time insist for Universities to generate internal revenue to become self-sufficient. The Finance Committee meeting held on 27th January 2017 also reiterated (FC: 03.03.11) the aspect. The reduced generation of revenue hinders much of University's development activities. At present the sources of revenue for the University are overhead charges (10%) of the project costs, sale of tender forms, sale of usufructs from the University land trees, amount of application fees of various recruitments conducted, sale amount of scrap/obsolete items and admission fees and hostel rent collected from the Students.

The scope for major chunk of revenue generation is from the students' fee portion. The Students' fee was last hiked during July, 2014. It is proposed to effect the minimum hike of all compulsory fees by 10% from the existing (including Hostel fee) w.e.f. the Academic Year 2017-18 onwards.

The Executive Council resolved to enhance all the mandatory fees by 10% including the hostel fee w.e.f. the Academic Year 2017-18.
